## What dialogue for a sustainable future?

Strengthening Ocean Health through Scientific Cooperation, Capacity Building, and the Science-Policy Interface

Taking place just after the One Ocean Science Congress and ahead of the UNOC Official Diplomatic Conference, this event will serve as a bridge between the scientific and political dimensions of UNOC3, through the lens of the role universities play in connecting knowledge and action. Showcasing examples of French and Costa Rican projects, the event will explore how universities contribute to ocean governance by bringing scientific expertise to public policy and strengthening the science-policy interface. Beyond engaging youth and training future leaders, universities co-develop science-based solutions through local to international cross-sectoral collaborations rooted in real-world challenges. The event will start with an opening session on Costa Rica's unknown treasures.
